The City is once again engaging with citizens to gather information on how they travel to, around and through Vaughan to help inform the future of the Vaughan Transportation Plan.

1. Review material online and provide input.

Content will be available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. You will be able to provide input directly on the site by responding to survey questions.
