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Improvements are coming

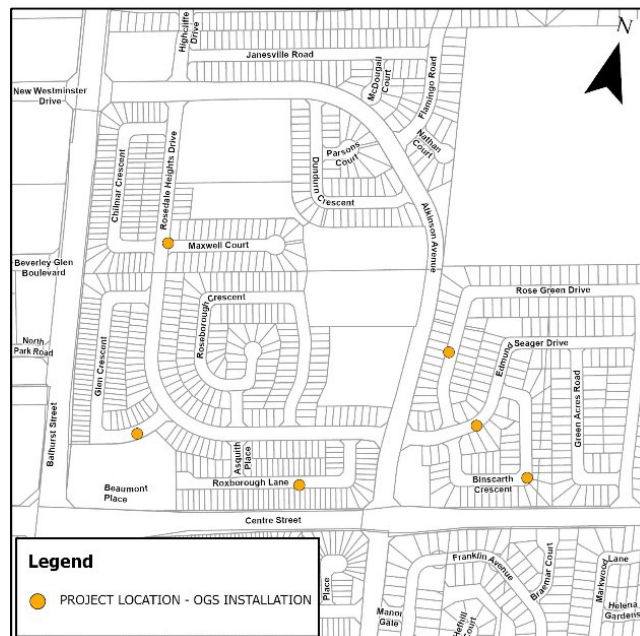
The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements to the following locations in Thornhill:

- Beaumont Place
- Binscarth Crescent
- Edmund Seager Drive
- Glen Crescent
- Maxwell Court
- Rosedale Heights Drive
- Rose Green Drive
- Roxborough Lane

New Oil and Grit Separator (OGS) units will be installed within the storm sewer system, as part of the **2023 Capital Works Program**. The OGS units are similar to storm manhole structures and are vital to the City's stormwater infrastructure.

Project update

The City has completed phase two of the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund – Oil and Grit Separator Program. The next phase, which is the construction and installation process, is expected to be complete by **December 2023**.



Construction scope

Work includes the installation of OGS units and related stormwater infrastructure within paved roadway areas. Watermain adjustments may be required to accommodate the new units. All temporary water disruptions will be communicated directly to the impacted residents.

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary detours will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

Construction timelines

Construction is scheduled to begin by **early September 2023** and is anticipated to be complete by **December 2023**.
