**RE: Bike Lanes Status Update for Napa Valley Avenue**

Bike lanes were approved by Council in June 2013 for Napa Valley Avenue, between Islington Avenue and Rutherford Road. The bike lane design is now complete and we are ready to begin installation, but the cold weather is already here and there are fewer cyclists on the road. The City has therefore decided to defer installation until Spring 2014. If weather permits, City staff will soon be installing new posts so they are ready for the signs to be attached when the pavement markings are painted, and we will make every endeavor to complete the bike lanes as quickly as possible in the spring.

Watch your mailbox in Spring 2014 as we will send you another notice and an educational brochure before the bike lanes are installed. We will also set up mobile signs informing you when the pavement markings and signs will be installed. The City will officially open the new bike lanes in the spring and will be offering free bike tune-ups and cycle training through the Recreation and Culture Department for residents.
