



# Cycling Facilities, Watermain, and Road Improvements

## What improvements are being made?

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in your community, including new cycling facilities, streetlighting upgrades, watermain replacement, and road reconstruction.

The construction of in-boulevard cycle tracks and streetlight improvements on Atkinson Avenue will expand and improve the City's cycling network within the community.

The improvements will also include watermain replacement and road rehabilitation on Centre Street and Atkinson Avenue. The existing watermains are approaching the end of their effective service life and as a result, these metallic watermains are susceptible to breaks that may result in frequent service disruptions. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

The project is currently in the design stage and construction is anticipated to commence spring 2023.

## Pre-Construction Field Work | Spring/Summer 2022

This spring, City-retained engineering consultants will be commencing field activities, including topographic surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation work. The various underground utilities (i.e. gas, telephone and hydro) will be identified by coloured paint markings.

All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery department.

### Construction locations:

- Atkinson Avenue, from Bathurst Street to Centre Street
- Centre Street, from Bathurst Street to Atkinson Avenue
